## McClintock

On **Saturday, July 24th, at 8:30 AM**, Cub Scouts and Scouts are invited to attend Camp McClintock STEM Day Model Rocket Launch.

**Scouts will have the opportunity to launch model rockets they have built.**

The Council has easy-to-build model rockets and several 1/2 A engines.

**Rockets must be built before arriving at camp** (the glue will not have time to harden if built that morning at camp).

**If your unit needs model rockets for your Scouts please contact the Scout office.** Scouts may bring other rockets (engine size 1/2 A, A, B, or C) they have built to launch, but we only have 1/2 A size engines. You will need to bring your own engines to launch other sizes.

While waiting to relaunch your rockets, Scouts can participate in **Asteroid Orbit, Comet Crash, and Trajectory Testing STEM activities.** This is open to all Cub Scouts, Scouts, and adults. We will launch all morning barring bad weather.

Please contact Glendon Sanders with how many Cubs/Scouts plan on attending, or if you wish to volunteer and help with the launches.

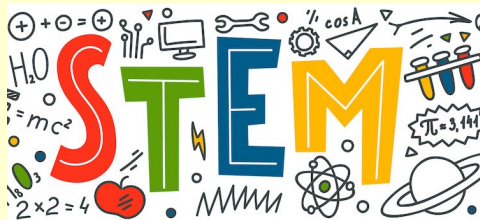

## **Fall Camporee - Scouting the Osage Trail**



**When:** September 10-12

**Where:** Camp McClintock

**Cost:** \$15 per Scout / \$25 per Scout after August 29th

The Fall Camporee will be at Camp McClintock, starting at 6 PM on Friday, September 10th, and ending by Noon on Sunday, September 12th.

Scouts will be competing as teams in a scored competition on Saturday. No merit badge instruction will be given per se, but Scouting activities may count toward merit badges the Scout has already begun (backpacking, fishing, camping, etc.).

The competition will cover many of the skills required between Scout and First Class rank - shooting skills, orienteering, problem-solving, and teamwork.

Teams will consist of between six and ten Scouts. Units may enter more than one team, but team members cannot switch teams. Units with two few Scouts to form a team will be combined. Units may combine with other units before arrival and develop their team roster(s).

This will be a trekking/backpacking adventure during the day, so be sure to bring proper attire, outdoor essentials, and backpack/day bags. HINT: the challenges will require some outdoor essentials and test your knowledge in outdoor skills. Pack wisely, but do not bring the kitchen sink!

Units are responsible for their own meals. Cracker barrel will be provided on both Friday and Saturday evenings.

We are working on a new registration system through the council website to register and hopefully pay by the end of July.
