Fall Camporee - Scouting the Osage Trail



When: September 10-12

Where: Camp McClintock

Cost: \$15 per Scout / \$25 per Scout after August 29th

The Fall Camporee will be at Camp McClintock, starting at 6 PM on Friday, September 10th, and ending by Noon on Sunday, September 12th.

Scouts will be competing as teams in a scored competition on Saturday. No merit badge instruction will be given per se, but Scouting activities may count toward merit badges the Scout has already begun (backpacking, fishing, camping, etc.).

The competition will cover many of the skills required between Scout and First Class rank - shooting skills, orienteering, problem-solving, and teamwork.

Teams will consist of between six and ten Scouts. Units may enter more than one team, but team members cannot switch teams. Units with two few Scouts to form a team will be combined. Units may combine with other units before arrival and develop their team roster(s).

This will be a trekking/backpacking adventure during the day, so be sure to bring proper attire, outdoor essentials, and backpack/day bags. HINT: the challenges will require some outdoor essentials and test your knowledge in outdoor skills. Pack wisely, but do not bring the kitchen sink!

Units are responsible for their own meals. Cracker barrel will be provided on both Friday and Saturday evenings.

We are working on a new registration system through the council website to register and hopefully pay by the end of July.
