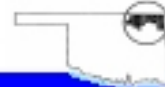

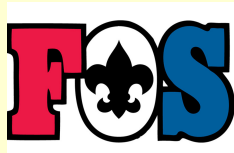

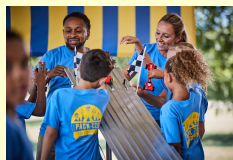

Where: First Christian Church Celebration Hall - 102 W. 4th St., Grove

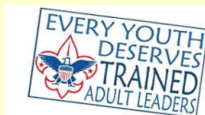
We will have racing classes for each Cub Scout Rank and an Open Class for parents/siblings and older Scouts.
