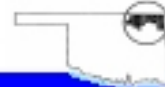

Important Information about Citizenship in Society Merit Badge



The Citizenship in Society merit badge is unique in the way it is conducted. Unlike other merit badges, the counselor for the Citizenship in Society merit badge is not a "subject matter expert" who is teaching the merit badge. Instead, the merit badge counselor for this merit badge facilitates the discussion.

This merit badge is best conducted in small groups of 3 to 6 Scouts who are of similar age. The counselor leads a discussion with the youth discussing their experiences and ways to be good citizens in society. For some requirements, the permission of the Scout's parent or guardian is needed.

BSA **requires** that anyone who is a Merit Badge Counselor for Citizenship in Society complete several training modules before they can be approved to be a counselor for this merit badge.

What: During the event, residents line up in their vehicles to drop off their hazardous waste at each location.
