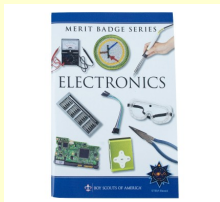

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) is the required outdoor training for Scoutmasters / Assistant Scoutmasters. The skills taught are based on the outdoor skills found in *The Boy Scout Handbook* and focuses on skills that build confidence and competence in leaders conducting outdoor camping experiences.

The registration fee covers camping, training materials, insurance, and food. Participants will be formed into patrols on site. **Overnight camping is part of the instruction and course.** Participants **MUST** attend the entire course to complete the training.

The Oklahoma State Society level winner receives \$500 and the winner at the Bartlesville Chapter level receives \$100.
