This course (along with CPR/AED certification) is required for Scouting America units to attend National High Adventure camps (Philmont, Northern Tier, Sea Base, The Summit).

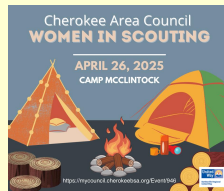

Bruce has influenced a great many young people over the decades. His ready and willing attitude, with a steady hand and constant smile, has served Scouting for a long time. He

epitomizes what makes Scouting work, year in and out.

When the LDS announced they would formally separate from Scouting (effective December 31, 2019) Bruce contacted the Pawhuska Episcopal Church to find a solution that allowed **Troop 43** to forge ahead. That new partnership returned Scouting to the site (in fact, the same room) as the very first Scout troop in America had met in 1909 when chartered from England. What a great legacy!
